



Child Sexual Exploitation Half Day Workshop

What is this course about?

This half day workshop aims to raise all professionals' awareness of CSE and their role in identifying and addressing it.

Who is this course suitable for?

This course is intended for all professionals working with children and young people who wish to improve their knowledge of CSE

Participants must have completed the CSE Awareness Training e-learning (or equivalent) before being accepted on this course.

What are the learning outcomes for this course?

By the end of the course participants will have:

- Improved recognition of CSE and vulnerabilities to becoming a victim
- Knowledge of and confidence in undertaking risk assessments
- Understanding of what CSE looks like in Cumbria
- Understanding of how to engage with victims, parents and carers
- Improved awareness of the legislation, research and policy context
- Improved knowledge of safety planning and offender disruption
