The Giant Puppet Parade will leave the Civic Centre and make its way into the city centre.

The conclusion of the Puppet Parade will be short drama-piece. The play will be set between 1568 and 1587 and focuses on the events leading up to the execution of Mary Queen of Scots and her time as a prisoner at Carlisle Castle. The play is written from the perspective of a football commentator overseeing the events unfold.
