## Can Facts:

# GLASS

## Glass Facts:

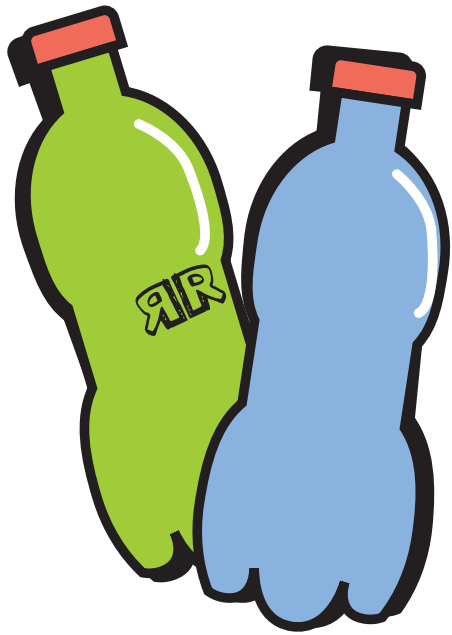
- ✓ Glass can be recycled again and again without losing its clarity or purity.

# PAPER

## Paper Facts:

- ✓ Over Christmas as much as 83 km<sup>2</sup> of wrapping paper will end up in UK rubbish bins, enough to cover an area larger than Guernsey.



# PLastic

## Plastic Facts:

- ✓ Recycling just one plastic bottle saves enough energy to power a 60W light bulb for six hours.
- ✓ It takes just 25 two litre pop bottles to make one adult size fleece jacket.

## Card Facts:

- ✓ Recycling cardboard only takes 75% of the energy needed to make new cardboard.
- ✓ Recycling 1 ton of cardboard saves 46 gallons of oil and recycling 1 ton of corrugated cardboard saves 700 gallons of water.

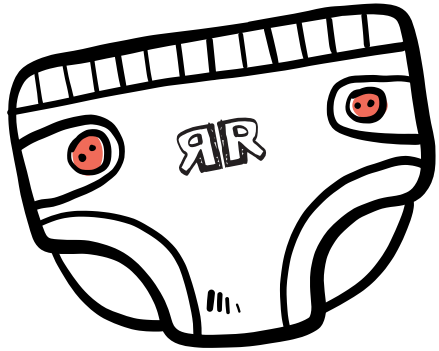


# Garden waste
