



One sheet of A4 paper takes over 5 litres of water to make! This takes into account growing the tree and the water used in manufacturing paper.

1 A4 sheet of paper weighs 5 grams, therefore 5 grams of paper uses 5 litres of water. So 1 gram of paper uses 5 litres of water.

On average a paperback book weighs 450g. The production of this paper emits 7.5kg, or 7500grams of carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) emissions. Therefore 1 gram of paper produces 17grams of CO<sub>2</sub>.
