

Library Concessions July 2016

- You must hold FULL library membership to qualify for a concession.
- Please check to see if any of these concessions apply to you.
- Evidence of your status may be required as detailed below.
- All library members get 2 free hours PC access.

Concession

Under the Age of 19:

- Are not charged fines on books or talking books
- Can request items from within the county free of charge

Unemployed or on a Low Income:

- Can request items from within the county free of charge

Disabled:

- Will not be charged fines on books, talking books or CDs
- Can borrow talking books free of charge
- Can request items from within the county free of charge
- Can borrow music compact discs free of charge

Aged 60 or Over:

- Will receive a discount on fines payable on books and talking books
- Will receive 50% discount on in county request charges

Evidence required

- Birth certificate
- Driving Licence
- Passport

- An Award Notification Letter
- Customers in receipt of Child Benefit alone will not qualify for a concession.

An Award Notification Letter or written documentation from either:

- Department for Work and Pensions
- A representative of the NHS
- A recognised organisation with whom they have links because of their disability

- Birth certificate
- Driving Licence
- Passport
