 - applications for new postal votes or applications to change or cancel an existing postal or proxy vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on WEDNESDAY, 24 FEBRUARY 2016
 - o applications for new proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on WEDNESDAY, 2 MARCH 2016
- 6. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on polling day, Thursday, 10 March 2016. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday, 2 March 2016. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday, 2 March 2016.
