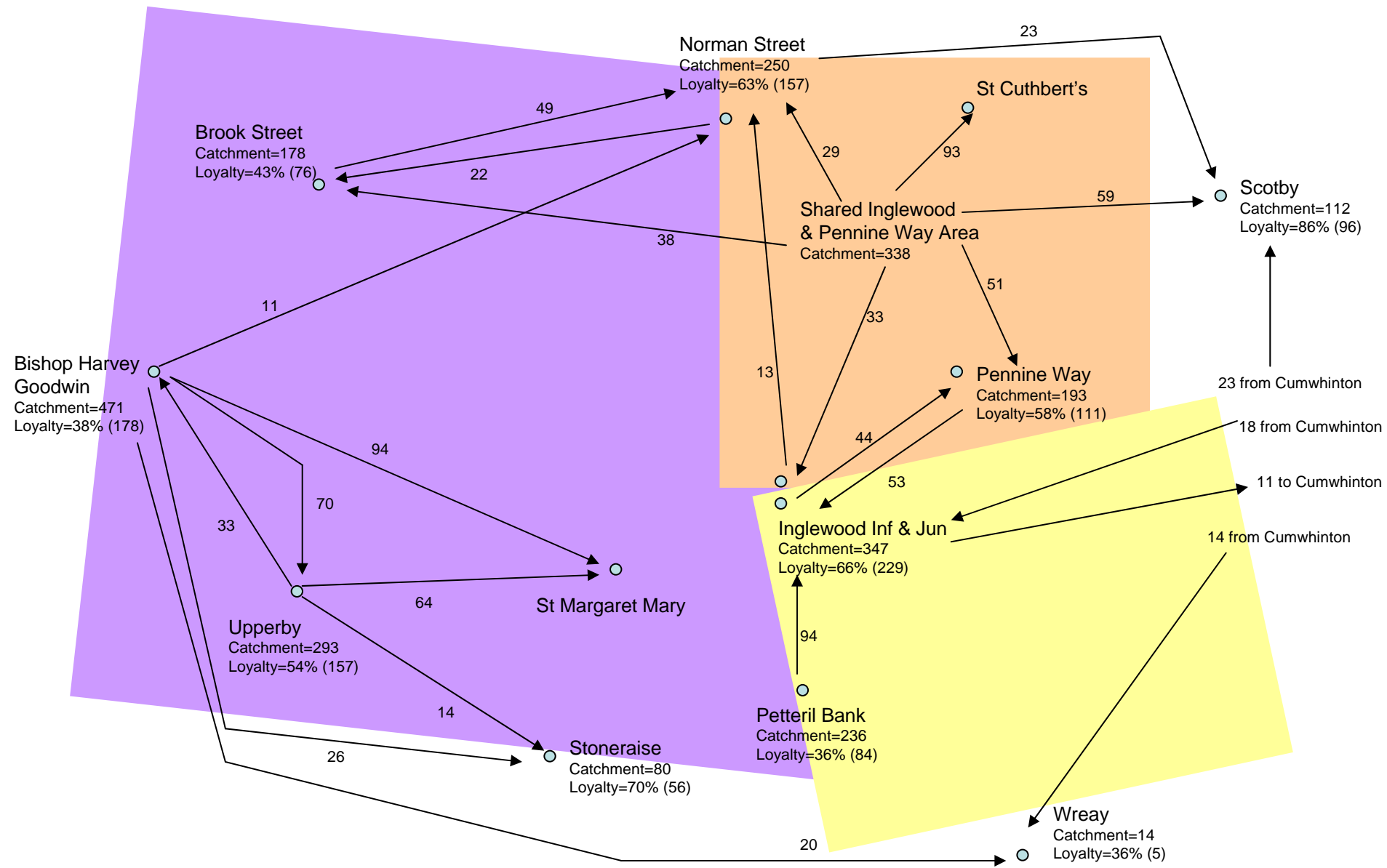

Pupil numbers

- County council receives information from GPs about births in catchment areas
- In Carlisle generally, and particularly in South and Central areas, the number of school age children is increasing
- Proposal is to increase total number of reception places from 384 to 477 in Carlisle South / Central

Carlisle South & Central and Parental Choice 4-11



Brook Street

- Additional 15 places per year group
- Remodel part of former music centre to provide classroom space
- This would provide space for youngest pupils, freeing up classroom space in main building

Petteril Bank

- Additional five places per year group
- A former classroom on the main site could be brought back into use
- This space has been used for non-teaching purposes for some time

Inglewood Infants & Juniors

- Additional six places per year in Infants
- Additional 15 places per year in Juniors
- Both schools already have accommodation to admit 90 pupils
- This just needs to be formalised

Pennine Way

- Additional 40 places per year group
- This would require extensive building work
- Proposal is to create a new building on the site of North Cumbria Technology College
- This would keep the school in the community and help regenerate the local area

- Additional seven places per year group
- Some internal remodelling and an extension needed

- Additional 20 places per year group
- Would require construction of four new classrooms on current site
