

**Commons Act 2006 - Section 15
APPLICATION TO REGISTER A NEW TOWN OR VILLAGE GREEN**

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Mrs Belinda Fox, Mrs Catherine Fenton & Mr Christopher Castle** ("The Applicants") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 15(1) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to land at Scaws Drive Field, Penrith shown outlined in red on the attached plan ("the Application Land").

The summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The application seeks the inclusion in the register of town and village greens of the Application Land which is claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green on 4 August 2014 by virtue of use of the land for lawful sports and pastimes by local inhabitants as of right for not less than 20 years.

If the registration authority is satisfied that the Application Land qualifies for registration and grants the application, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by registering the land as a new Town or Village Green.



- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and
- must be sent to: The Commons Registration Service, Lady Gillford's House, Petteril Bank Road, Carlisle, Cumbria, CA1 3AJ or email: commons.registration@cumbria.gov.uk

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the commons registration authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may also be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at 5pm on **8 February 2017**.
