

**Commons Act 2006 - Section 19(2)(a)
NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO CORRECT THE REGISTER**

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Robert Charleton Thornton (Trading As J.C. Thornton & Son)** ("the Applicant") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 19(2)(a) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register unit CL68, Birkby Fell - Muncaster.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: Entry numbers 21 and 22 were registered as a result of application number 1422 of 24 February 2012 ("the 2012 Application") which sought to apportion the right formerly registered at entry 19. The Applicant claims that the apportionment calculation contained within the 2012 Application was incorrect and that Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority was bound to verify the application in order to ensure compliance with subsection 9(5) of the Commons Act 2006. The Applicant claims that the Commons Registration Authority made a mistake either by not doing so, or by doing so incorrectly, by approving the application and so concluding that the land to which the right registered at entry 21 is attached carried the right to graze 81 adult sheep and followers or 8 cows and followers or their equivalents.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by deleting entry number 21 and creating a new entry, which will entitle the Applicant to graze 183 adult sheep and followers or 18 cows and followers or their equivalents and 1 horse on the whole of the land comprised in the register unit.



- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the Commons Registration Authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The date on which the period for making representations expires is **5pm on 11 August 2017**.
