

**Commons Act 2006 – Schedule 3**  
**NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND THE REGISTER TO RECORD AN HISTORIC EVENT**  
**Secondary Application - Apportionment**

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Margaret Elizabeth Lord** (“the Applicant”) to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Schedule 3 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register CL94 Western Mallerstang Common, south of Friths.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze 300 ewes with their followers and 150 gimmer hogs or sheep and cattle together on the basis of one head of cattle to 10 sheep over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit (“the Right”) is registered as attached to Hazel Gill Farm, Mallerstang, Westmorland comprising O.S. plots numbered 262, 263, 269, 270, 274, 275, 292, 301, 302, 305, 328, 329, 336, and 337 together with Hall Hill Farm, Mallerstang, Westmorland comprising O.S. plots numbered 293, 296, 298, 299, 300, 303, 306, 307, 308, 324, 325, 326 and 327 all on the O.S. Map (Edition of 1915) of the Parish of Mallerstang, Westmorland at entry 10 of register unit CL94.

The Applicant seeks by this application to show that the portion of the Right associated with O.S. field 299, for which severance is claimed, amounts to 1.149 ewes and 0.574 gimmer hogs.

This secondary application can only be considered if the primary application (CA14/44) is granted. If granted the Commons Registration will give effect to the determination by creating a new entry in the register (making reference to entry 10) to show the proportion of the Right attached to O.S field number 299 as severed and held in gross.


Any person wishing to make representations:

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the authority to disclose information received from you to others, which will include the Applicants and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at **5pm on 30<sup>th</sup> March 2018**.
