

Commons Act 2006 – Schedule 3 NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND THE REGISTER TO RECORD AN HISTORIC EVENT Secondary Application - Apportionment

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Askham Bryan College** (“the Applicant”) to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Schedule 3 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register CL60 Carrock Fell and Mungrisdale Fell.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze 40 ewes and 12 ewe hogs on Bowscale Fell, comprising the whole of the land in this register unit (“the Right”) is registered as attached to O.S. plots numbered 57, 58, 56, 95, 96, 97, 98, 99, 100, 125, 102, 103, 94, 131, 132, 133, 130, 129, 128, 134, 126, 127, 136, 202, 205, 142, 143, 145, 150, 151, 152, 153, 154, 155, 156, 157, 158, 159, 160, 161, 162, 163, 164, 165, 166, 189, 190, 245, 244, 246, 247, 241, 243, 694, 693, 695pt, 690, 677 and 676 at entry 19 of register unit CL60.

The Applicant seeks by this application to show that the portion of the Right associated with O.S. fields 133, 130 and 131, for which severance is claimed, amounts to 0.52 ewes and 0.16 ewe hogs.

This secondary application can only be considered if the primary application (CA14/55) is granted. If granted the Commons Registration will give effect to the determination by creating a new entry in the register (making reference to entry 19) to show the proportion of the Right attached to O.S field numbers 133, 130 and 131 as severed and held in gross.


Any person wishing to make representations:

- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person’s interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must state the grounds on which they are made and must be signed by the person making them;

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the authority to disclose information received from you to others, which will include the Applicants and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at **5pm on 25th July 2018**.
