

At Mid-2019 Barrow-in-Furness's population was estimated to be 67,000;

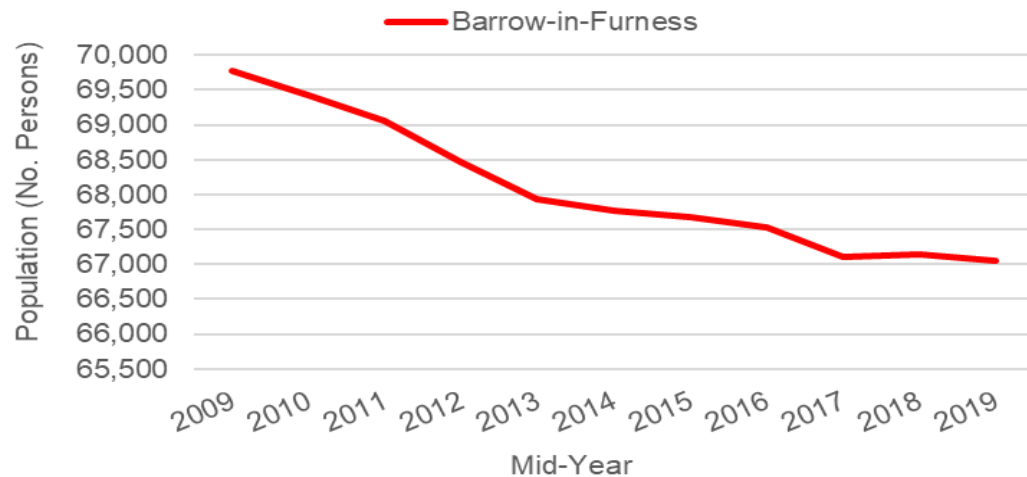
When compared to England & Wales, Barrow-in-Furness has lower proportions of residents in the three youngest age groups (0-44 years), higher proportions of residents in the 45-84 age groups, and a similar proportion of residents in the oldest age group (aged 85+);

Since Mid-2018, the population of Barrow-in-Furness has decreased very slightly (-0.1%) The greatest percentage increase occurred in the 75 - 84 age group (+3.6%) and the greatest percentage decrease occurred in the 45 - 59 age group (-1.3%);

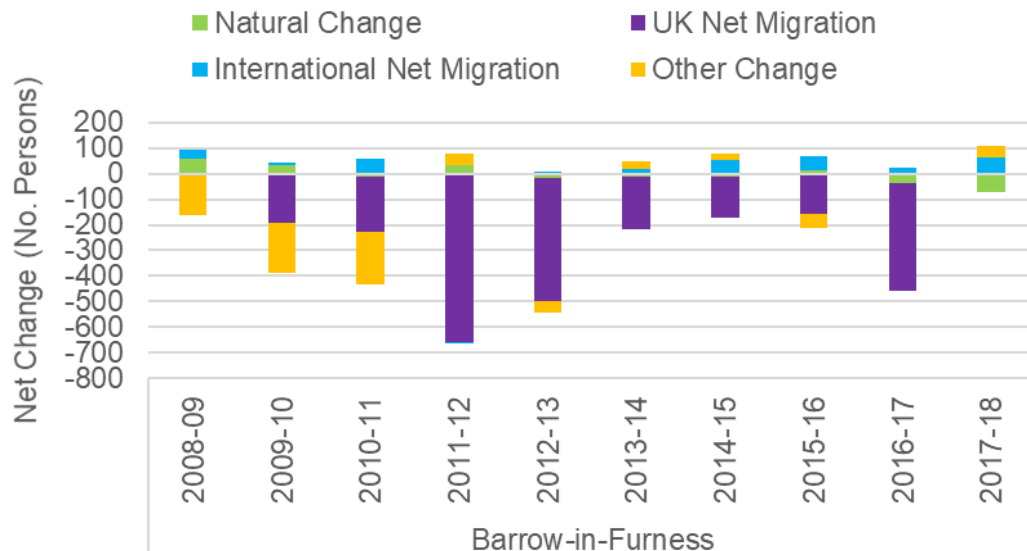
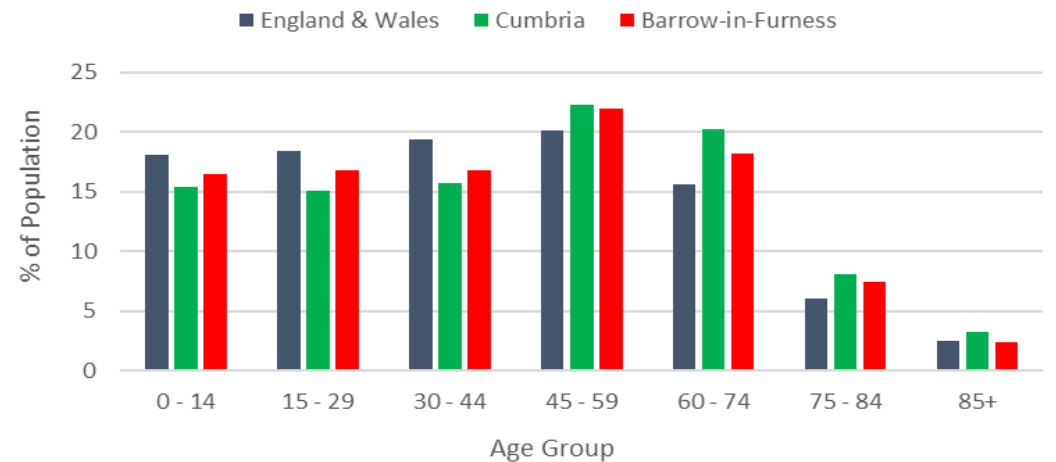
