

Is Your School Ready to Implement the New Cumbria RE Syllabus?

Course Outline:

This online course provides an opportunity for governing bodies to be introduced to the new Cumbrian Locally Agreed Syllabus for Religious Education (RE). This is the legal document for the teaching of RE in Community and Voluntary Controlled schools. It is reviewed every five years and adjusted accordingly depending on national RE priorities. Academies are also advised, and welcome to use this syllabus. The Locally Agreed Syllabus will become statutory from September 2024.

- To ensure school governors are aware of the intent behind the new Cumbrian Agreed Syllabus for RE (2023)

- To outline how governors can support RE Leads/departments to be ready to implement the new syllabus by September 2024
- To signpost further training opportunities and resources to support the implementation of the new syllabus
- To ensure that the new syllabus will impact on the religious literacy of the pupils at your school
