## The Commons Act 2006 - Section10 NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO ATTACH A RIGHT TO LAND

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by Joyce Haze! King ("the Applicant") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 10 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register unit CL45 Thwaites Fell.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The Applicant is the registered owner of the rights of common registered at entries 33, 36 and 42 of the register unit CL45 Thwaites Fell ("the Rights"). At present the Rights are registered as not attached to land (held in gross). By this application, the Applicant seeks to attach the Rights to Boadhole Farm, comprising O.S. fields numbered 8823, 8333, 9620, 0294, 0707, 0824, 1909, 0133, 2294, 1283, 0180 and 1734 (Rural Land Register Map 2015) shown edged blue on the attached map.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by deleting current register entries 33, 36 and 42 and making reference to the new corresponding entry/entries, and making additional entry/entries in the register to show the Rights as attached to Boadhole Farm along with the addition of a new supplementary map showing the boundaries of Boadhole Farm.

Any person wishing to make representations:

- must quote the Application No. CA4/1
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the Commons Registration Authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities. Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.
