a) Upgrading Boltons Footpath 10 (211010) to Public Bridleway which runs from Point A on the application map (OSGR NY 24792 43956) the western termination of the application route at the junction with C2020 103, to Point B (OSGR NY 25514 44091) the eastern termination of the application route at the junction with U2134 102.


