Cumbria County Council will be holding public information drop-in sessions to update local businesses and residents on the plans for Road Safety Improvements on the A592 between Rheged and Windermere.

We are planning to hold drop-in sessions on the following dates and times:

Monday 13 September between 2:00pm – 7:00pm in Glenridding Village Hall, Glenridding

Thursday 23 September between 2:00pm – 7:00pm in The Marchesi Centre, Windermere

At each session you will have the opportunity to view plans for the whole route, discuss the proposals and ask questions. There will also be information on the timing of the works and how we are keen to work together with local businesses and residents to minimise disruption as much as possible.
