

**THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, BARROW-IN-FURNESS)  
(CONSOLIDATION AND MINOR AMENDMENT OF  
TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) (ORDER 2001) VARIATION ORDER (NO.39) 2021**

1. The Cumbria County Council hereby give notice that on 13 July 2021 it made the above Order under Sections 1, 2, 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53, 64 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The Order will come into operation on 2 August 2021 and its effect will be to: -
  - (a) Introduce “Prohibition of Waiting (At All Times)” restrictions on parts of the following roads in Barrow-in-Furness: -

Andrews Way, Duchy Court, Elterwater Crescent, Friars Lane/Priors Path, Hawcoat Lane/Baldwin Street, Hawcoat Lane/Oxford Street, Highlands Avenue/Rating Lane, Highlands Grove/Highlands Avenue/Maylands Avenue, Infield Park, Kendall Croft, Lesh Lane/Rising Side, Moor Tarn Lane, North Scale, North Scale (The Crown), Oxford Street/Clarence Road, Park Lane, Phoenix Road, Promenade, Rear Greengate Street/Florence Street, Spring Grove and Winchester Street;
  - (b) Introduce “Prohibition of Waiting (At All Times)” restrictions on parts of Beckside Road, Cleater Street, Coronation Drive, Fairview/Chapel Street, and Garden Terrace/Hamilton Terrace, Dalton-in-Furness;
  - (c) Introduce “Prohibition of Waiting (At All Times)” restrictions on parts of Duke Street/School Street, Ireleth Road, and Sandy Lane/Duke Street, Askam-in-Furness;
  - (d) Introduce “Limited Waiting Parking Place, Mon-Sat 8 am-6pm, 2 hours, no return within 2 hours” on part of Lawson Street, Barrow-in-Furness;
  - (e) Alter the extent of the existing “Limited Waiting Parking Place (At All Times) 2 hours, no return within 2 hours (permit holders exempt)” on parts of Abercorn Street, Aberdare Street, and Ayr Street, Barrow-in-Furness;
  - (f) Alter the extent of the existing “Limited Waiting Parking Place Mon-Sat 8am-6pm 1 hour no return within 2 hours” on parts of Milton Street, Barrow-in-Furness;
  - (g) Alter the extent of the existing “Limited Waiting Parking Place Mon-Sat 8 am – 6 pm, 2 hours no return within 4 hours (permit holders exempt)” on parts of McClintock Street and Nelson Street, Barrow-in-Furness;
  - (h) Introduce “No Loading or Unloading and No Waiting At Any Time” restrictions on part of Cornwallis Street, Barrow-in-Furness;
  - (i) Alter some existing parking restrictions to allow for the introduction of Advisory Disabled Parking Bays on parts of Abercorn Street, Aberdare Street, Ayr Street, Holker Street, McClintock Street, Milton Street and Nelson Street, Barrow-in-Furness;
  - (j) Replace the existing Advisory Disabled Parking Bays with statutory Disabled Parking Bays on parts of Devonshire Street, Schoolwaters, and Newton Road, Dalton-in-Furness and Middlefield, Barrow-in-Furness; and

(k) Remove the existing Disabled Parking Bay on Kent Street, Barrow-in-Furness as it is no longer required.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks of 13 July 2021 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
