

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (VARIOUS ROADS, EDEN AREA) (APPLEBY HORSE FAIR) (CONSOLIDATION AND PROVISION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS) ORDER 2021

1.

The Cumbria County Council hereby give notice that it proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 47, 51, 52, and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”)

2.

The effect of the proposed Order will be to consolidate the existing provisions of The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Eden Area) (Appleby Horse Fair) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2014 and The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Eden Area) (Appleby Horse Fair) (Consolidation and Provision of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2014) Variation (No. 1) Order 2015, into one concise Order **and introduce the following proposed new restrictions during the lead up to and during the Appleby Horse Fair:-**

between 30 April and 30 June inclusive annually – “Prohibition of Motor Vehicles, Horse Drawn Vehicles and Ridden or Accompanied Horses (Except for Access)”, on the U3337 Castle Bank, from Jubilee Ford to its junction with the B6260; and

between 30 April and 30 June inclusive annually – “Prohibition of Horse Drawn Vehicles and Ridden or Accompanied Horses”, on the B6260 Bridge Street and the B6542 The Sands.
