Schedule

A raised speed table is proposed to be removed from Meadow Road, Whitehaven, at a point 11.5m north of its junction with Uldale Road and reconstructed at a point approximately 112m north of Uldale Road.

The table surface will be approximately 4.8m in length and approximately 6.5m in width.

Ramps on each approach to the table are to be 1.5m (1500mm) in length, not exceeding 75mm in height, with a maximum gradient of 1 in 20.
