

**The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Carlisle Urban And Rural Area)  
(Consolidation And Minor Amendment Of Traffic Regulation) (Order 2001)  
Variation (No. 61) (Zone E Review) Order 20><**

Statement of reasons

Following comments from residents regarding difficulty in parking due to hospital traffic and the length of time since parking Zone E was last reviewed we are proposing to make some alterations to the Zone.

Cumbria County Council considers that it is expedient to propose to make the above order for the following reasons set out in Section 1(1) Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:

Proposed 1 hour disc bay restrictions to replace the existing two hour disc parking restrictions, Between the hours of 8am – 8pm Monday to Friday and 8am- 6pm Saturday. disc parking residents of zone E exempt,

On the following streets; Ashley Street, Bright Street, Canal Court, Duke Street, Granville Road, Hawick Street, Head Street, Howard Street, John Street, Kendal Street, Leatham Street, Morton Street, Newcastle Street, Newtown Road (part of – 8-18, 17-15, 26-44, 27-41, 50-74, 57-61, 85-92, 93-99, 113-119, 165- 160, 169-177), Peel Street, Potters Place, Rigg Street, Silloth Street, Wood Street, Wigton Road (part of – 1 to 11), and York Street, for the following reason set out in Section 1 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

(f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

Proposed provision of new disc parking bays, waiting limited to 1 hour, Between the hours of 8am – 8pm Monday to Friday and 8am- 6pm Saturday. disc parking residents of zone E exempt,

On the following streets: Bower Street, Brookside, Brookside Place, Cranbourne Road, Hawick Street, Lawson Street, John Street, 161-179 and 84-92 Newtown Road, Peel Street and Ruthella Street, Carlisle;

(f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs

Proposed provision of new of No Waiting At Any Time (NWAAT) restrictions

On the following streets: Ashley Street, Bellgarth Road, Bower Street, Brookside, Brookside Place, Canal Street, Clift Street, Cranbourne Road, cul-de-sac nos. 21-39 Brookside, Head Street, Kendal Street, Ruthella Street and Newtown Road, Carlisle for the following reason set out in Section 1 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:-

- c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

Provision of disabled bays, 24 hours a day, seven days a week,

On Lawson Street and Kendal Street

- (f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs
