Biggar Bank Road, Barrow
Provision of Traffic Calming Scheme (Speed Cushions)

Cumbria County Council has been requested by Councillor Frank Cassidy to design and consult upon additional safety measures to improve the road safety conditions on Biggar Bank Road.

Following the introduction of the road narrowing scheme in early 2020 it was requested that additional measures in the form of vertical traffic calming be considered. As part of the overall traffic calming measures for Biggar Bank Road, we are proposing to construct speed cushions at three locations. The introduction of the speed cushions would be the final part of the scheme and conclusion of the measures on Biggar Bank Road.

Please see the enclosed plan to show the details of the proposed locations for speed cushions. There will be one speed cushion between the pinch point outside 14 & 15 Biggar Bank Road, one between the pinch point outside the West Shore Bowling Club & Institute, and two outside 38 & 39 Biggar Bank Road.

If you wish to comment or object about the proposed speed cushions you can send your responses to the email address at the top of this letter. The consultation and objection period is 21 days and the deadline for replies is **19 March 2021**.

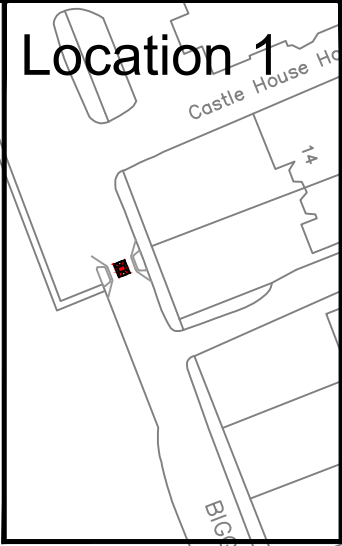
Speed cushions are proposed to be installed at the following locations on the U6243 Biggar Bank Road, Walney: -

1. At a point approximately 107m south of its junction with Beach Crescent (U6245). There will be one cushion at this location.
2. At a point approximately 50m south of its junction with Water Garth (U6244). There will be one cushion at this location.
3. At a point approximately 24m south of its junction with Petrel Bank (U6342). There will be two cushions at this location.

The speed cushions will be constructed of reinforced concrete and the dimensions will be as follows:-

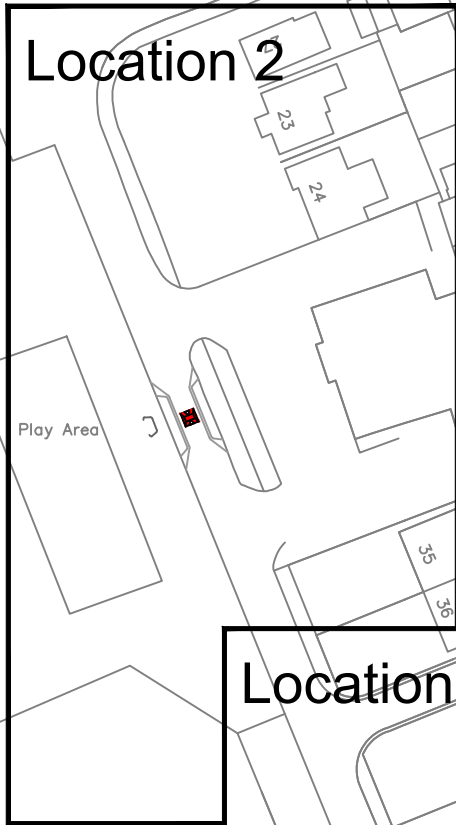
Height -	70mm

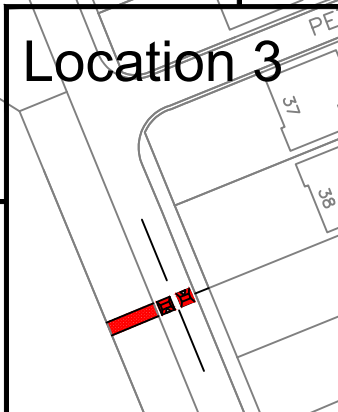

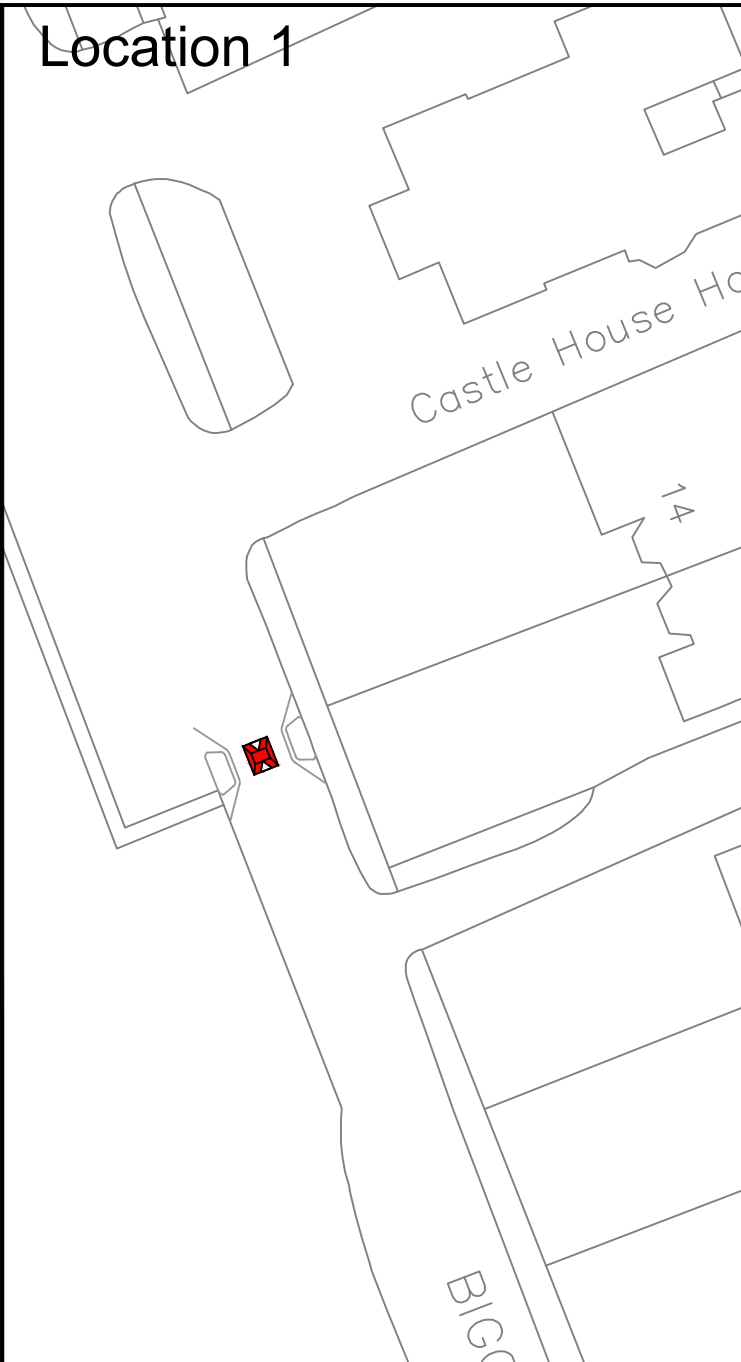

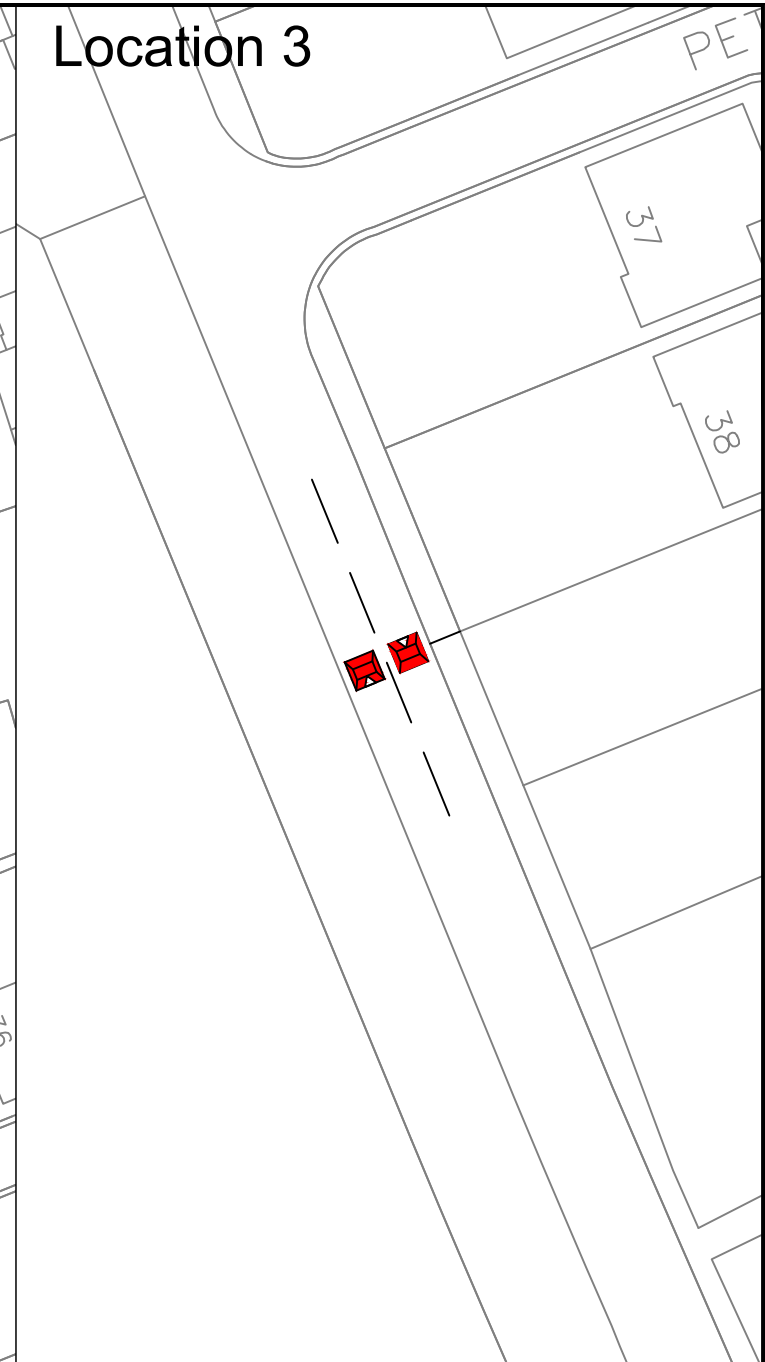
