

The County of Cumbria (Various roads, Carlisle Urban and Rural area) (Consolidation and Minor Amendment of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2001) Variation Order (No. 59) (Sewell Lane, Carlisle) Order 2021

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 22 March 2021 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Carlisle Urban and Rural Area) (Consolidation and Minor Amendment of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2001) Variation Order (No. 59) (Sewell Lane, Carlisle) Order 2021.
2. For the purposes of this Order the expression “the 2001 Order” shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Carlisle Urban and Rural Area) (Consolidation and Minor Amendment of Traffic Regulations) Order 2001
3. The 2001 Order shall have effect as though: -

(a) The following entry in Schedule XXX – “One-Way Traffic” – Carlisle, was deleted in its entirety: -

| Street Name | Restriction | Restricted Length |
|-------------------------|-----------------|---|
| Sewells Lonning (U1164) | One Way Streets | From a point 130m north of its junction with the A6 (Carleton Road) travelling in a south westerly direction to a point 25m north of its junction with the A6 (Carleton Road) |

(b) The following was added to the “Arrangement of Articles”: -

Part VIII – Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles Exceeding 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Vehicle Weight

(c) The following was added as Part VIIIA “Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles Exceeding 7.5 Tonnes Maximum Gross Vehicle Weight”: -

Part 8A

Prohibition of heavy commercial vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes maximum gross vehicle weight

24A. Save as provided in Article 24B, no person shall cause or permit any heavy commercial vehicle exceeding 7.5 Tonnes maximum gross vehicle weight to proceed along the U1164 Sewell Lane, Carlisle from its junction with the A6 Carleton Road, for its entire length.

24B. Nothing in Article 24A shall apply to: -

(a) Vehicles being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or a vehicle (other than a passenger vehicle) in the service of a local authority or water authority which is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties; or

(b) Vehicles being used by statutory undertakers or their contractors in connection with the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or in land adjacent to that length of road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984.

4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
