

**The County of Cumbria (various roads, South Lakeland area)  
(Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2002) (Arnside) Variation  
Order 2021**

1. The Cumbria County Council hereby give notice that on 13 July 2021 it made the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The Order will come into operation on 19 July 2021 and its effect will be to: -
  - (a) Introduce “No Waiting for Caravans, Twin Unit Caravans and Motor Caravans between 9.00 pm and 8.00 am the following day, Monday to Sunday inclusive” restrictions , on parts of Station Road and The Promenade, Arnside;
  - (b) Introduce “No Waiting At Any Time” restrictions on part of the southeast side of The Promenade, Arnside;
  - (c) Remove a section of “No Waiting At Any Time” restriction on the south side of Red Hills Road, Arnside; and
  - (d) Remove a section of “No Waiting 10.00 am – 6.00 pm, Full Week” restriction on the southeast side of The Promenade.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks of 13 July 2021 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 19 July 2021 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) (Order 2002) (Arnside) Variation Order 2021
2. For the purposes of this Order the expression “the 2002 Order” shall mean The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area) (Consolidation of Traffic Regulations) Order 2002
3. The 2002 Order shall have effect as though: -

**(a) the following was added as Article 91A:**

91A. No person shall cause or permit a caravan or a twin unit caravan or a motor caravan, to wait between the hours of 9.00 pm and 8.00 am the following day, Monday to Sunday inclusive, in the lengths of road or sides of road specified in Schedule 72B of this Order.

**(b) the following was added as Schedule 72B: -**

**(c) The following were added to the definitions in Article 2: -**

“caravan” means any structure designed or adapted for human habitation which is capable of being moved from one place to another (whether by being towed, or by being

transported on a motor vehicle or trailer) and any motor vehicle so designed or adapted,

but does not include—

(a) any railway rolling stock which is for the time being on rails forming part of a railway system, or

(b) any tent;

as defined in Section 29 of the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960;

“twin unit caravan” means: -

(1) A structure designed or adapted for human habitation which—

(a) is composed of not more than two sections separately constructed and designed to be assembled on a site by means of bolts, clamps or other devices; and

(b) is, when assembled, physically capable of being moved by road from one place to another (whether by being towed, or by being transported on a motor vehicle or trailer), shall not be treated as not being (or as not having been) a caravan within the meaning of Part 1 of the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960 by reason only that it cannot lawfully be so moved on a highway when assembled.

"motor caravan" has the same meaning as in Regulation 2(1) of the Motor Vehicles (Type Approval) (Great Britain) Regulations 1979 ("a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted for the carriage of passengers and their effects and which contains, as permanently installed equipment, the facilities which are reasonably necessary for enabling the vehicle to provide mobile living accommodation for its users").

(d) The following entry was added to Schedule 52, Part 5 Miscellaneous “No Waiting At Any Time”: -

**Statement of Reasons**

*(As amended by the Leader Decision Record of 18 June 2021)*

Cumbria County Council considers that it is expedient to propose to make the above Order for the following reasons set out in Section 1(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984: -

(a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the roads or any other roads or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, or

(f) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the roads run.

**Station Road/The Promenade, Arnside**

**Proposed “No Waiting for Caravans, Twin Unit Caravans and Motor Caravans 9.00 pm – 8.00 am, Full Week**

It has been observed that numerous vehicles, caravans, twin unit caravans, motor caravans and campervans park on The Promenade and on Station Road, Arnside.

Due to the width of the road and the amenities of the area, such parking in the area hinders traffic movements and is leading to an increase in anti-social behaviour in the area overnight.

The aim of the proposals is to help with the passage of vehicles, emergency and service vehicle movements and to improve visibility and provide a passing place for vehicles on those sections of Station Road and The Promenade by the provision of areas of “No Waiting at any time” (NWAAT) (double yellow lines) and the removal of a length of “No Waiting 10.00 – 6.00 pm full week” restriction (to be replaced with NWAAT).

**Red Hills Road, Arnside**

**Proposed removal of “No Waiting At Any Time”**

It has been observed that this section of “No Waiting At Any Time” restriction is no longer necessary now the youth hostel is no longer in operation. It has been raised by the wider community and is no longer supported. The aim of these proposals is to preserve the amenities of this area by reducing unnecessary road markings

**Leader Decision Record**

Having taken into account the objections and representations which were received during the statutory consultation and advertisement, and having also taken into consideration the matters contained in Section 122(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which are more specifically referred to at paragraph 8 of this Leader Decision Record, the Leader approves the bringing into



operation of *The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, South Lakeland Area)(Consolidation of Traffic Regulations)(Order 2002) (Arnside) Variation Order 20><* ("the Order"), as advertised, SAVE FOR the following amendment in relation to Red Hills Road, so that extent of the No Waiting At Any Time restriction is amended to the following - "From a point 20 metres south west of its junction with the projected southern kerb line of Lawrence Drive in a predominantly easterly direction for 144 metres". This is a reduction of 90 metres in total as shown on the amended plan in Appendix 5.

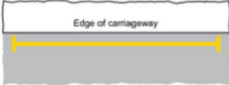

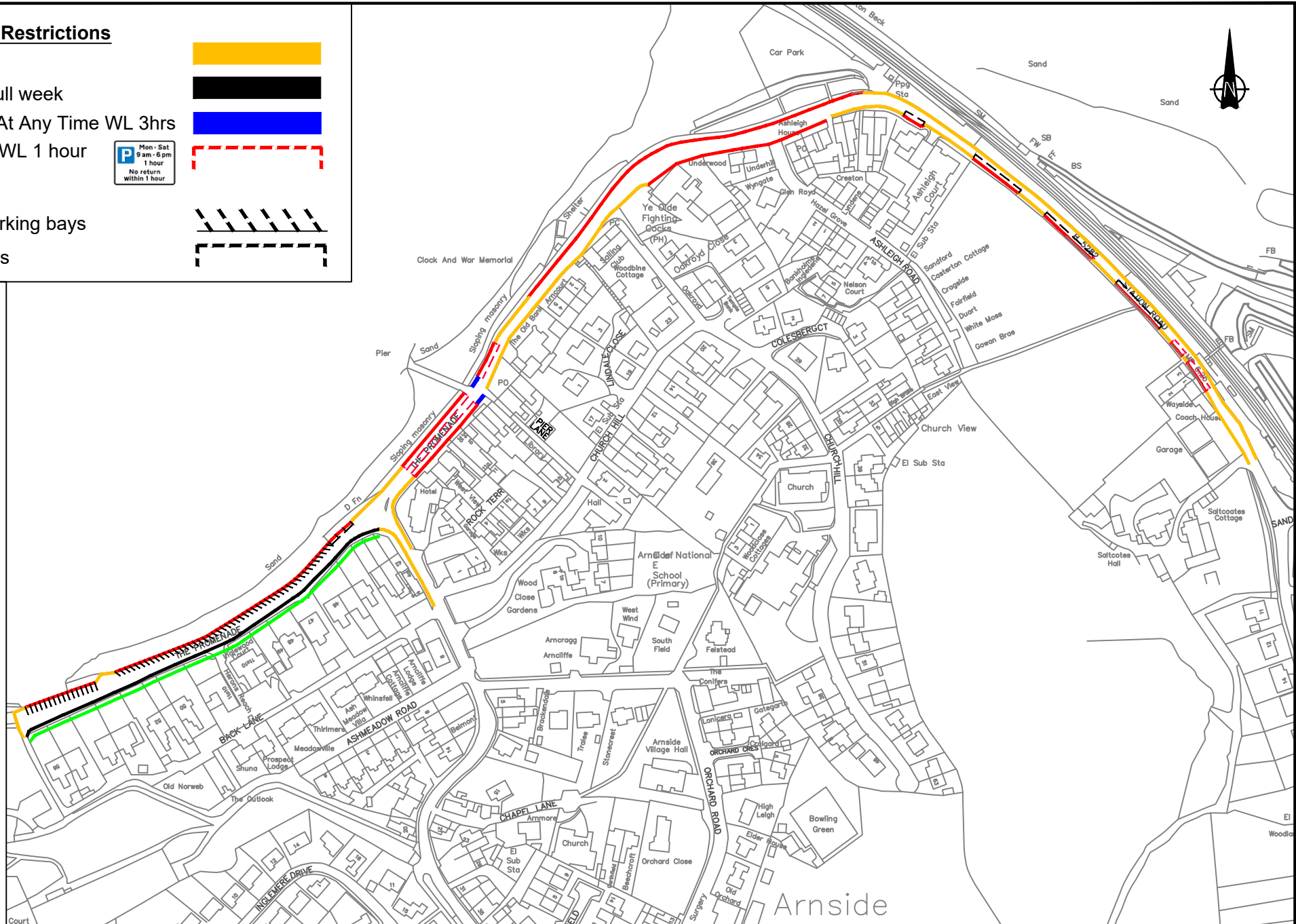
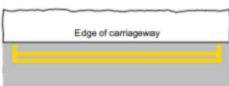
