The County of Cumbria (Various Roads in the District of South Lakeland) (Consolidation and Provision of Speed Limits) (Order 2018)
Variation Order (No.4) 2021

1. The Cumbria County Council hereby give notice that on 22 June 2021 it made the above Order under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The Order will come into operation on 5 July 2021 and its effect will be to: -
 - (a) Introduce a 20 mph speed restriction on the entire lengths of Crescent Green and Mint Street, Kendal;
 - (b) Replace the existing 40 mph speed limit on Castle Green Road, Kendal with a 30 mph speed limit, and continue the 30mph along Singleton Park Road, for a distance of 168m in a southerly direction,
 - (c) Introduce a 40 mph speed limit on Singleton Park Road, Kendal, from the termination of the 30 mph extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 155m.

4. If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks of 22 June 2021 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
