

# STATUTORY DECLARATION


## SECTION 31(6) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

I, ANTONY JOHN FITZHERBERT-BROCKHOLES, AS A TRUSTEE OF THE C E TRYON-WILSON WILL TRUST DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. The Wilson family of Dallam Tower, Milnthorpe have for over 200 years been the owners of lands and property known as The Dallam Tower Estate, part of which is more particularly delineated on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 31<sup>st</sup> day of January 2008, We the Trustees of the C E Tryon Wilson Will Trust as current owners of the Dallam Tower Estate, deposited with Cumbria County Council, being the appropriate Council, a statement accompanied by a plan delineating our property by red edging which stated that the ways coloured brown on the said plan and the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as highways with vehicular status (Byways Open to All Traffic), the ways coloured purple on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as bridleways and the ways coloured green on the said plan and on the plan accompanying this declaration had been dedicated as footpaths. No other ways had been dedicated as highways over our property.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statement dated 31<sup>st</sup> January 2008 referred to in 2 above and at the present time we have no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over our property.

AND I MAKE this solemn declaration on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of February 2008 conscientiously believing it to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declaration Act 1835

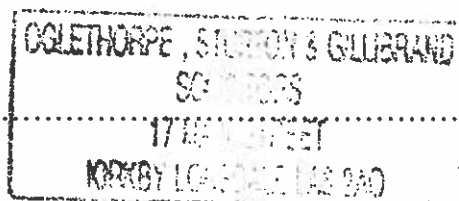
