

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (FOOTPATH NO.323005 IN THE PARISH OF
GLASSONBY AND FOOTPATH NO.331015 IN THE PARISH OF HUNSONBY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2017

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Order made by Cumbria County Council on 18 July 2017, which became operative on 23 July 2017, due to the continued likelihood of danger to the public, as a result of damage caused by flooding at Lacy's Caves and to enable repair works to be carried out ("the Works") and which would otherwise expire on 23 July 2023

:has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 23 July 2024.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along the following lengths of footpath:-

1. Footpath No.323005 in the Parish of Glassonby from Dale Raven Bridge, Grid Ref: 356559 539522, extending in a southerly direction to its junction with Footpath No.331015 and continuing on to;
2. Footpath No.331015 in the Parish of Hunsonby – for its entire length.

There is no suitable alternative route available for pedestrians.
