

WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL (FOOTPATH NO. 302146
IN THE PARISH OF ALSTON MOOR) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF
PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Order made by Westmorland and Furness Council on 13 June 2023, which became operative on 19 June 2023, due to the continued likelihood of danger to the public, as a result of bridge repair works to be carried out (“the Works”) and which would otherwise expire on 19 December 2023

:has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 19 December 2024 or completion of the works, whichever is earlier.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along an approx. 37 metre section of footpath 302146 in the Parish of Alston Moor between grid references: 372424, 542882 and 372444, 542912.

There is no suitable alternative route available for pedestrians.

If the works have not been completed within the extension period, the order may be extended for a further period with the approval of the appropriate minister.
