Grizzly Bear: Grizzly bears are found throughout Western Canada, the northern United States and Alaska. Brown bears, including the grizzly bear, are easily recognized by their most distinctive feature, their shoulder hump. Super strong shoulder muscles help this bear to dig up roots and tear apart logs to find food. These muscles are located in the 'hump' of the brown bear. When making their dens, Brown bears can easily move rocks and logs and dig through hard soil and rocky ground using their long sharp claws.
