



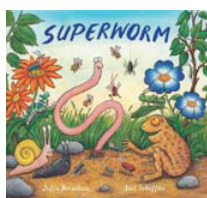

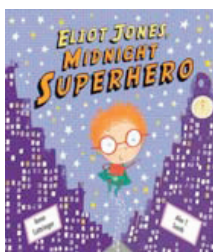
Superbat. Matt Carr

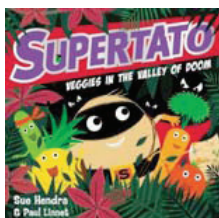
Superdad's Day Off. Phil Earle
