## Remember the best rewards include YOU

- Inexpensive rewards, especially those that involve spending time with our children are the best.
- Children thrive when we describe exactly what they did that was good, so verbal praise is a great reward in itself.
- Young children also need the rewards to be frequent, so it is best if they are able to earn a reward each day.
